# Let us tell you **Errol Doebler's** story

Errol Doebler has lived a life few can imagine. A graduate of the United States Naval Academy and former Navy SEAL, Errol's resume also includes Army Ranger and FBI Counter Terrorism Expert. Years of training, education and experience, from both the military and the private sector, are the foundation for his keynote presentation on leadership, process and motivation.

Doebler's career began when he graduated from the United States Naval Academy in 1991. He furthered his commitment to the military by being accepted into the elite Navy SEAL program, where he continued to serve as an Assistant Platoon Commander at SEAL Team Four and a Platoon Commander at SEAL Team One. Having sustained injuries on deployment, his Navy SEAL career was cut short, and he was medically discharged from the United States Navy.

Doebler's determination to serve his country wasn't over and this setback became an inspiration. Following the events of 9/11, Errol applied for service to the Federal Bureau of Investigation. It was there that he investigated terrorist groups from Afghanistan, Pakistan, India and the Former Soviet Republics. Eventually Doebler went on to become a member of the FBI's New York SWAT team. He gained resilience and mental strength through these high ranking positions, and it's these experiences which provide the infrastructure for his leadership development tools.

After thirteen years, Errol Doebler left the FBI and began his leadership consulting firm, Leader 193. Through his firm, he's worked with executives and teams from Fortune 100 companies to small, regional offices, in addition to professional sports organizations and small technical startups. Errol Doebler's resume sounds too unbelievable to be true, yet it is. His background has taught him about the process of leading and his value is in teaching that to others. He wants to help others achieve this, both in the workplace and beyond. Errol has quickly become a sought after speaker, not only because of what he's been able to accomplish but for how he inspires your audience to achieve what *they* want to accomplish.
